GARRETT MORGAN WAS AN AMERICAN INVENTOR AND COMMUNITY LEADER. GARRETT AUGUSTUS MORGAN WAS BORN IN KENTUCKY ON MARCH 4, 1878. IN 1895, MORGAN MOVED TO CLEVELAND, OHIO TO WORK AS A SEWING MACHINE REPAIRMAN. IN 1907, HE STARTED HIS FIRST BUSINESS, A SEWING EQUIPMENT AND REPAIR SHOP. IN 1914, HE INVENTED AN EARLY GAS MASK CALLED THE SAFETY HOOD AND SMOKE PROTECTOR. IN 1923, HE **INVENTED THE TRAFFIC SIGNAL. HE INVENTED MANY THINGS** INCLUDING A ZIG-ZAG STITCHING MECHANISM, HAIR DYEING OINTMENTS, AND CARVED-TOOTH PRESSING COMB. MORGAN DIED ON AUGUST 27. 1963. IN CLEVELAND.
